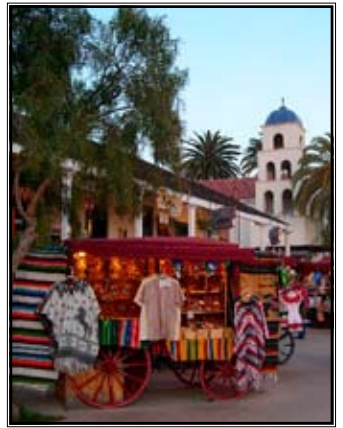


**Governance Support Conference
